An Important Message from the Peace Garden Crew . . .

Cardboard Again???

Yes, folks we're collecting cardboard again, but this time it is for a new project. We spend a lot of time weeding our bountiful Peace Veggie Garden. One task we are hoping to lessen is the weeding we need to do on our walkways between the beds. An eco-friendly way to do this is to line our paths with a layer or two of cardboard, then cover with woodchips. This technique is actually quite effective at holding back the weeds. Another bonus is that it breaks down naturally and uses no harmful weed killer near our precious plants.

We just want plain cardboard boxes that are free of packing tape and labels. You can easily remove tape and labels using heat from a hair dryer. No shiny plastic-coated cardboard. Please flatten your cardboard before you bring it in to leave in the Fellowship Hall for collection.
