### Lenten Fellowship Project

The Sunday School Lenten Fellowship Project is to support RamPacks in their mission of supplying over 250 students in the Pennridge School District. RamPacks provides food on weekends and school holidays to children facing food insecurities. Each week RamPacks fill packs for hungry students with breakfast, lunches and snacks. The students in the elementary, middle, and high schools receive free or reduced rate breakfasts and lunches at school during the week, but are at risk of having little to eat over the weekends and holidays.

Through your monetary support, each of these children would receive a bag of food costing between \$8 and \$10 each weekend and holiday. RamPacks is also in need of donations of small individual-size bags of snacks; such as, Doritos, chips, and sandwich crackers.
