In preparation for Peace's 1st Martin Luther King Day of Service activity, our December/January fellowship project is to collect women's feminine hygiene products and toiletries. Please place your donations in the box in the narthex from December 15th through January 19th.

Project #1: Join us for a fun MLK service project helping local animal shelters. In this family/team project, Peace members will construct interactive toys for cats and dogs, including cardboard cat playhouses! Between now and January 20th, please save the following items to bring to the event.

- Sturdy corrugated cardboard boxes (12"x12"x12" up to 16"x18"x30"). Plain clean cardboard is preferred, but not 100% necessary.
- Sturdy cardboard mailing tubes (any length).
- Toilet paper and paper towel tubes.
- Used (clean and not frayed) blue jeans and sweatshirts.



Project #2: We will be collecting and packing feminine hygiene kits for the homeless, to be sent to the Welcome Church in Philadelphia. Donations of sanitary pads, tampons (both unscented) and WetOnes travel packs are welcome and can be placed in the coatroom.

We would also welcome donations of any new, unused sturdy dog toys to take to the shelters following the event.
