A Focus on a Peace Ministry

The Faith and Fellowship Committee meets to discuss and implement faith development and growth within our congregation and our community. It also plans and carries out fellowship opportunities for all our members and friends here at Peace. Currently, Pastor Gary, Dianne Steiner, Kristina Doherty, Judy Hamilton, Gary Schaeffer and Dottie Ritter are serving on the Faith & Fellowship Committee.

Sunday School is held every Sunday at 9:00AM during the fall, winter and spring months. Classes are available for preschoolers, ages 3 years through Kindergarten; 1st and 2nd Graders; 3rd through 5th Graders; and Middle School and High School students. An adult discussion group or a coffee and conversation time is offered in the Fellowship Hall.

In addition to our classes, the Sunday School students take part in many service activities that show our members at Peace God's love. Some of the things we did this past year were making and sending cards to our shut-ins, planting vegetable plants in the Peace Garden and flowers around the church, giving small gifts to our Peace members on special days, and presenting the Christmas story at Christmas. We also host Vacation Bible School here at Peace with St. Michael's Lutheran Church during a week in July for the children of our community.

This committee also provides many Christian fellowship opportunities for our Peace members and those in our community. WELCA, the Lunch Bunch, the Outdoor Service Group and the Peace Garden are all sharing circles that provide fellowship and service here at Peace. Also, monthly fellowship projects are chosen by the committee for the local and global communities in need. Our congregation supports charities; such as, RamPacks, toy collections for Gemma Services, making backpacks for the homeless in Philadelphia, and donating food for Pennridge FISH's food pantry to name a few of the projects that help care for and serve others.

Other fellowship activities that our committee is responsible for were the Easter breakfast, college scholarships and the Rally Day picnic. We also helped other committees with the Easter Egg Hunt, Craft Show, Stewardship Dinner, and Trunk or Treat.

With God's guidance through the leading of the Holy Spirit, this committee will continue to help Peace grow in faith, celebrate God's presence with us, care for all people in providing joyful fellowship, and serve others through acts of charity to our community and the world!
