A Focus on a Peace Ministry

In recent months, the newsletter has featured one or more of Peace Church's ministry groups with an in-depth description on their areas of focus and interest. This month Gary Schaeffer, Outreach Committee Chairperson, highlights this groups' focus at Peace.

The goal of Outreach is to provide opportunities for fellowship, worship and service with an effort to include persons outside the Peace congregation. Outreach attempts to increase the visibility of Peace in the community through activities and events held in the church, in the pavilion and around the area. The Outreach Team, Pastor Gary Costa, Dwight Dulsky, Mary Snyder, Cheryl Saint-Pol and Gary Schaeffer, are repeating the same events as last year; which are, Easter Egg Hunt, Craft Show & Marketplace, and Trunk or Treat. Here is a brief summary of these events.

- The Easter Egg Hunt continues to be a well-attended and much appreciated event. We
 distributed over a thousand candy stuffed plastic eggs to enthusiastic children from our
 congregation and the surrounding neighborhoods. We have great fun putting on this short but
 rewarding event.
- This year's Craft Show & Marketplace will be held at Peace on Saturday, September 28th from 10:00AM to 3:00PM, rain or shine. The proceeds from table rentals, donations and food sales will benefit Pennridge RamPacks. We have secured the vendors, and with additional signage for the show, we are hoping for an increase in public attendance. If you would like to help at the Craft Show & Marketplace, please contact Pastor Gary or any member of the Outreach Committee. A volunteer sign-up sheet in located in the narthex, for your convenience.
- Trunk or Treat will take place at the Peace Pavilion on Saturday, October 26th from 12:00Noon to 1:30PM. The fun at Trunk or Treat will include distributing candy and pumpkins, costume parades, trunk judging, pumpkin decorating and games. All ghouls and goblins are welcomed. More event information will be shared in the coming weeks.

All our Outreach events use the Peace Pavilion. Our pavilion is perched on the top of a hill with a view of the surrounding countryside. It is free to Peace members and available for a wide variety of functions. There is a small charge if our members need sexton services for orientation, setup, breakdown and cleaning. An article from the RamPacks News August 2024 Edition

RamPacks will begin our SIXTH year in September! Again, I cannot thank St. Paul's enough for your willingness to support us through the use of the Green Room for one of our pantries as well as the parlour/library for our Board Meetings. Our pantry here at St. Paul's serves Deibler Elementary, West Rockhill Elementary, South Middle School and Pennridge High School.

We will continue with three pantries (Blooming Glen Mennonite and Souderton Brethren in Christ) this year, but we are hoping to be able to store some food in a space available at St. Agnes which will help everything run smoother.

Beginning in September we will again be happy to accept donations of snacks to include in the bags. Some examples would be individual bags of chips, Doritos, peanut butter crackers, popcorn. There will be a labeled bin in the Narthex where you can place your donations.

This year, we are making an effort to get more MONTHLY donors. We currently have 20 people (some from St Paul's!) who have made a commitment to donate monthly. This is very easy to set up from our website http://www.rampacks.com. Those monthly donors make the budget more secure, which we need as numbers rise. Last year we started the year serving close to 200 children and ended the year serving close to 300! ALL donations go to buying food EXCEPT when we need to replace the delivery bins and reusable backpacks.

Our Food Fest in April was a success, and we will be making it an annual function. We are already scheduled for Sunday, May 4th at Pennridge High School, 12-4. Hopefully with the new location, we will be able to host more food trucks, vendors and still have the children's games, face painting, raffles and more!

Lastly, look forward to a community Food Drive in the month of February...show your LOVE to RamPacks! We will be asking churches, schools, businesses and local service organizations to partner with us asking for SPECIFIC foods from each all month.



The Sunday School classes will start their fall term on Sunday, September 8th, Rally Day, at 9:00AM. We are looking for another teacher to help team teach the middle school/high school class. All curriculum and materials are provided. This is a great way to get to know the teens of our church and help them grow in their knowledge and faith in our Lord!
